

Collingwood Residential Trapping Program – Draft in Development 03-04-2018

Trapping in residential areas in Collingwood has been discussed with several trappers. There are concerns with trapping such as;

1. Catching dogs and other wildlife.
2. Coyotes are intelligent and are less likely to be fooled once they see another coyote trapped. If they sense a trap they will stay away.
3. An effective trapping area is an area that coyotes pass through frequently.
4. An effective trapping technique is to bait and trap around the baited area. This would catch a number at a time.
5. The short-term trapping plan will unfortunately have to destroy coyotes (as permitted under the firearms by-law of Collingwood by a licensed trapper) or by injectoin by trappers who have the capability.
6. A long-term relocation trapping program is being explored but is very costly and initial research suggests the relocation will be harmful as they will be attacked by coyotes in another area as they are territorial. Relocation also presents issues for other areas given the over population of coyotes. Coyotes can be hunted to try and control their population. A small trapping program in Collingwood will also accomplish the MNRF control guidelines.
7. Catch and release in the Collingwood area will not be effective as they will return.

A sign was created at Park Sign Creative Inc, 24 Stewart Road, Collingwood, ON L9Y 4K1 705-444-1723. The sign is a 24” x 24” 10mm coroplast. The reference on file will be “coyote trapping” 02-23-2018. The price was \$68.50. Based on the interest we could have several signs printed and shared. It may also be possible to have them left at Park Sign Creative Inc for rent and pickup. ie a \$68.50 deposit and then a refund of \$30.00 on return.
