Could you please correct and reissue the agenda for the Council Meeting 04-16-2018. Several errors have been made;

1. The motion from the Corporate & Community Standing Services Committee Meeting 04-09-2018 has been altered to incorrectly and inappropriately influence and mislead Council members on the coyote concerns issue. This should be changed to reflect the motion accurately as depicted in 1.58.44 of the recording of the meeting.
2. There has been a significant prejudice and unfair representation to Council for the protection of coyotes and Staff proposed coexistence policy support while failing to represent Collingwood residents in this matter. The agenda as issued is very prejudicial to residents and without fair and accurate representation of Collingwood resident coyote concerns is an abusive and negligent development of policy. By controlling the agenda of Council in this way; staff have failed to operate in the best interests of residents of Collingwood.
3. Please receive attached Resident Report 04-15-2018 Coyote Concerns Collingwood for distribution to Council for review and consideration at the Council meeting 04-16-2018.
4. Please amend the agenda to include two equivalent deputation allowances for residents. Jeff Brown will present the Resident Report and request other residents to speak. On acceptance of the time slots, Jeff Brown will make best effort to advise in advance of the start of the meeting the names of the individual residents of Collingwood who will speak to Council on the coyote concerns matter.
5. The Town of Collingwood Clerks office should be removed from this process and appropriate oversight should be put in place to ensure fair representation is given to the residents of Collingwood.
