Thank you for your effort last night. I believe you understand the danger and threat from urban habituated coyotes, saw through the staff avoidance/delay of the issue and the Coyote Watch Canada charade – distract from the problem – blame residents – engage by-laws to solve the problem by fining a resident for feeding birds.
